Closure of the School for Winter Vacation

Due to the **extreme cold climatic conditions**, lack of adequate **heating facilities**, limited **comfortable school infrastructure**, and **heavy accumulation of snowfall** that blocks traffic movement across the entire Ladakh region, schools remain closed during winter.

Accordingly, Rainbow School remains **closed for three months**, from **December to 1st March**, as part of the annual **Winter Vacation**.

During this period, to keep students **academically engaged**, **Winter Home Assignments** are provided to all classes. Once the school reopens, teachers carefully **check and evaluate the assignments**, and marks are awarded accordingly. These marks are then **added to the students' overall academic assessment**.

This system ensures **continuity in learning**, maintains academic discipline, and helps students remain connected to their studies even during the long winter break

As recommended by the Chief Education Officer, Kargil / District Programme Officer, ICDS Project, Kargil and on the basis of decisions taken in the meeting held on 13th December, 2025 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chairman/CEC, LAHDC, Kargil in presence of Hon'ble Executive Councilors, LAHDC, Kargil, it has been decided to declare winter vacation in all the Government/ recognized private Schools as well as Anganwadi Centers of Kargil from 15th December, 2025 to 10th of March 2026.

As such, it is hereby ordered that all the Government Schools/ recognized private Schools, as well as Anganwadi Centers of District Kargil (**except Class 10th & 12th for which remedial classes are being in place**) shall observe winter vacation from 15th of December, 2025 upto 10th of March 2026.
