Exciting News – Upcoming Passive Solar Auditorium Hall at Rainbow School

Rainbow School is delighted to announce a major milestone in our development journey! We have received financial support from the Tibetan Children's Education Foundation (TCEF), Montana, USA, and APECIH, Switzerland, in collaboration with the Himalayan Institute of Alternative Learning (HAIL), Ladakh, who will be providing technical expertise for the construction of an all-weather, passive solar, multi-purpose auditorium hall.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) has been officially signed between TCEF, HAIL, APECIH, and Rainbow School to mark the beginning of this collaborative project.

The HAIL Architecture Team recently made their first visit to our campus to discuss the design plan and site orientation. We are excited to share that the execution phase of the TCEF/APECIH/HAIL/Rainbow School Auditorium Hall project will begin soon. This state-of-the-art facility will not only serve as a cultural and educational hub but also reflect our commitment to sustainable, climate-responsive infrastructure in Ladakh.
